## Dear parents/caregivers

It was wonderful to see so many families here last Thursday for our Student Led Conferences and the pride and confidence of all of our students sharing their learning with you. Thank you to all families that supported the Scholastic Book Fair with a significant amount of funding raised towards library and school resources. As you are aware this has been a difficult term in terms of student and staff absence through illness and other reasons. Unlike many school, we have ensured we have remained fully operational and this is thanks to a fantastic team of relievers and the flexibility of our staff. We have valued your support as parents in understanding that within any one week your child may have several different teachers, and this has been unavoidable, but has meant we have not had to switch to at home learning or bubble school. Now that international borders are opening and it is becoming easier for overseas travel we note that some families are requesting leave during school term time. Please note that in most cases (such as a holiday) the Ministry of Education requires that this leave be formally recorded as an unjustified absence from school. If you have been on school grounds recently you will have noticed the great progress the demolition team have made in the last two weeks, with the entire junior block now completely gone. Thanks for your patience with the change of pedestrian routes required, this will be a feature of our school as temporary fencing areas change. Over the holidays we are delighted that our long awaited sun canopy will be erected over the deck areas between Area 23 and 28. Consequently there will be large trucks driving through the school grounds during the holidays so please take extra care if you are using school playgrounds during the break. No children should be unsupervised on school grounds during the holidays due to these building projects causing significant and dangerous safety concerns.
