Albany Primary School New Classroom Block Update 2




Dear Bass Road residents

The Ministry of Education has approved a significant rebuild of half our school. A 20-classroom block (pictured above) has been designed in consultation with the school, reflecting a flexible learning environment and the need to meet the demands of our increasing roll.

As of the end of the school term (Friday 30th June) the site has been cleared in preparation for concrete footings. Consequently, there will be an increase in heavy construction traffic, trucks and heavy earth moving machinery. The school has stipulated construction vehicles and trucks can only enter school grounds after 9.30am and not between 2.30pm – 3.15pm on school days.

We apologise in advance for any inconvenience, as there may be some delays as you enter Bass Road, should trucks be turning right into the school site. The construction company (Watts and Hughes Ltd) have completed a separate entry for vehicles to support safety of students, and traffic flows.



Please be cautious if you are walking on the footpath adjacent to our bus bay for trucks entering or leaving the site.

You may also have noticed a new sign painted on Bass Road at the Bass Road / Albany Highway lights. This was provided by Auckland Transport to support the new legislation reducing the speed limit to 30k in surrounding and adjacent streets to schools.
